Step-by-Step Instructions

How to Draw a Triceratops

1. Start by drawing a circle for the head. Then, draw a line for the neck and another line for the body.
2. Add two small circles for the eyes and two larger circles for the nostrils.
3. Draw a curved line for the mouth.
4. Draw three horns on the head: two above the eyes and one on the nose.
5. Draw a large frill around the back of the head.
6. Draw four legs, each with three toes.
7. Add some details to the body, such as scales or wrinkles.
8. Erase any unnecessary lines.
9. Color your triceratops!

How to Draw a Stegosaurus

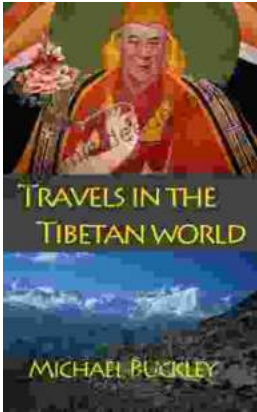

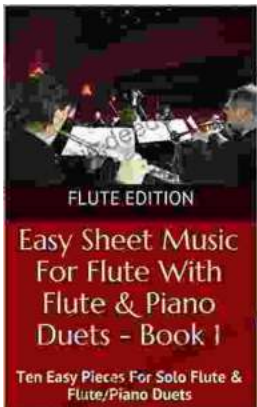
