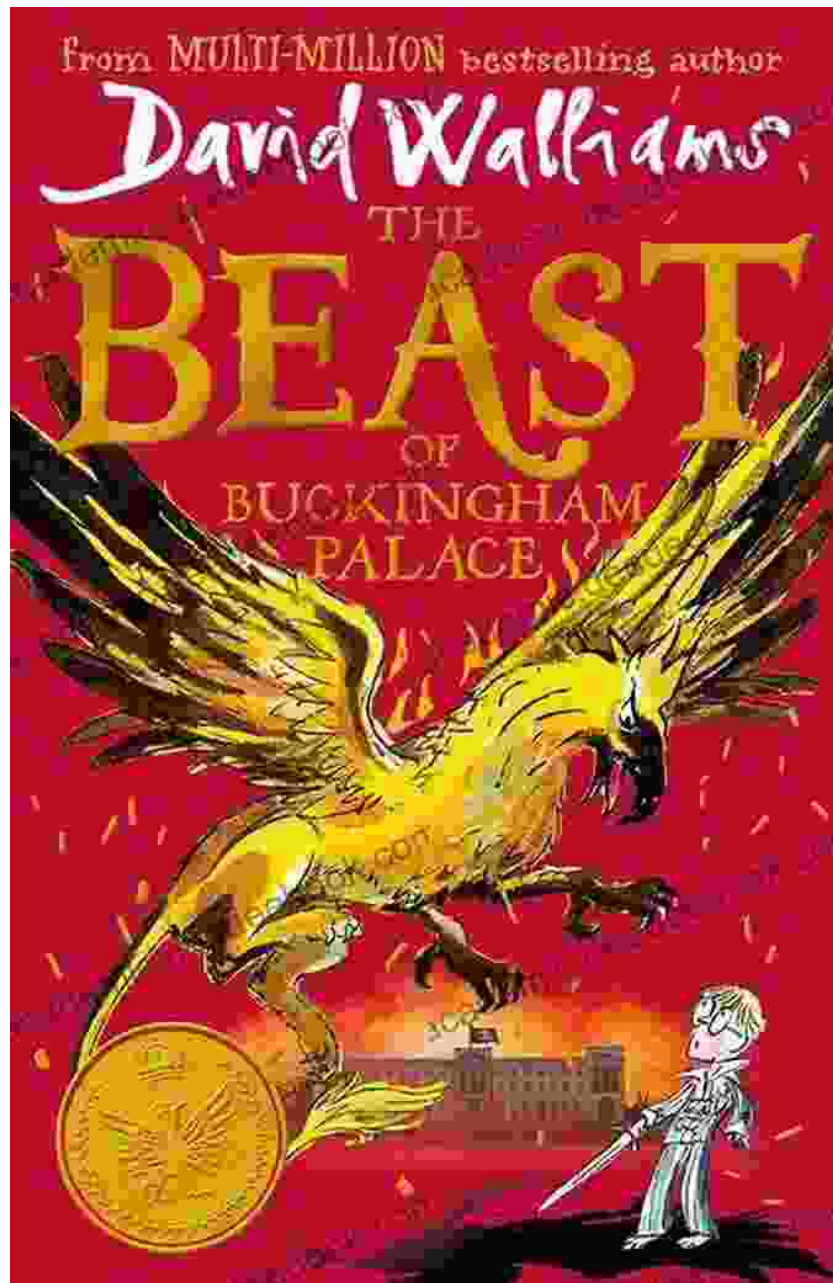

Tolkien attended Oxford University, where he studied English language and literature. After graduating, he worked as a professor at Oxford and Leeds University.

Tolkien began writing *The Hobbit* in the 1930s, and it was published in 1937. *The Lord of the Rings* was published in three volumes between 1954 and 1955.

Tolkien died in Bournemouth, England, on 2 September 1973, at the age of 81.

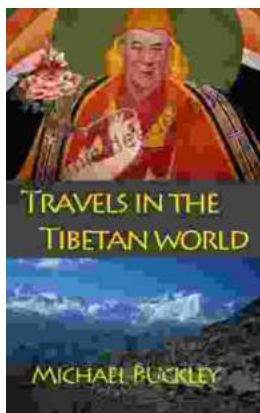
