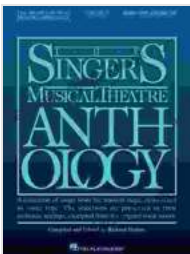

When performing songs from this anthology, it is important to use proper vocal technique to avoid vocal strain. Here are a few tips:

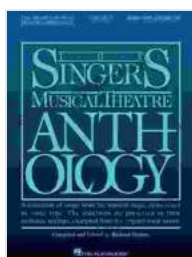
- Warm up your voice before singing.
