
## Title 33 Navigation and Navigable Waters

The Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) is a codification of the general and permanent rules published in the Federal Register by the executive departments and agencies of the United States. The CFR is divided into 50 titles, each of which represents a broad area of subject matter. Title 33 of the CFR covers navigation and navigable waters.






