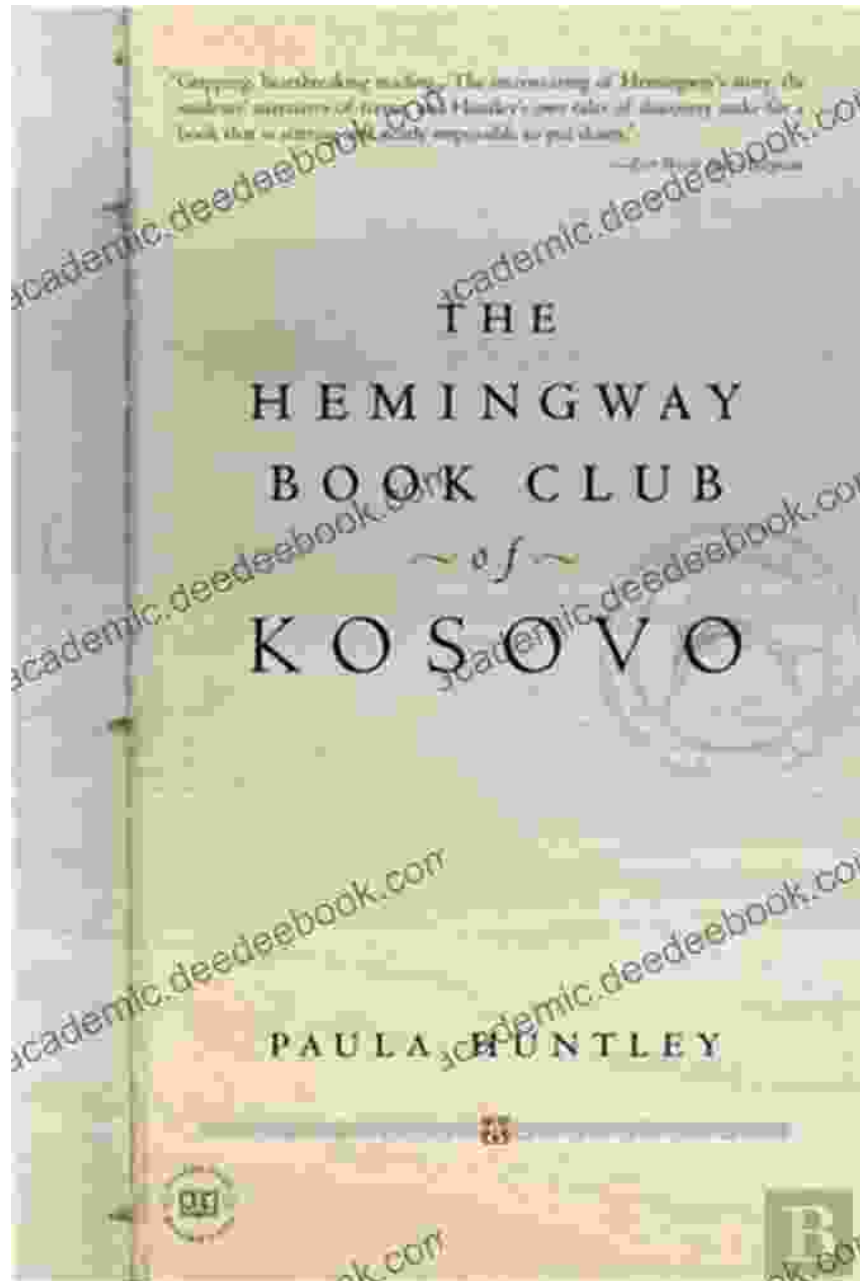

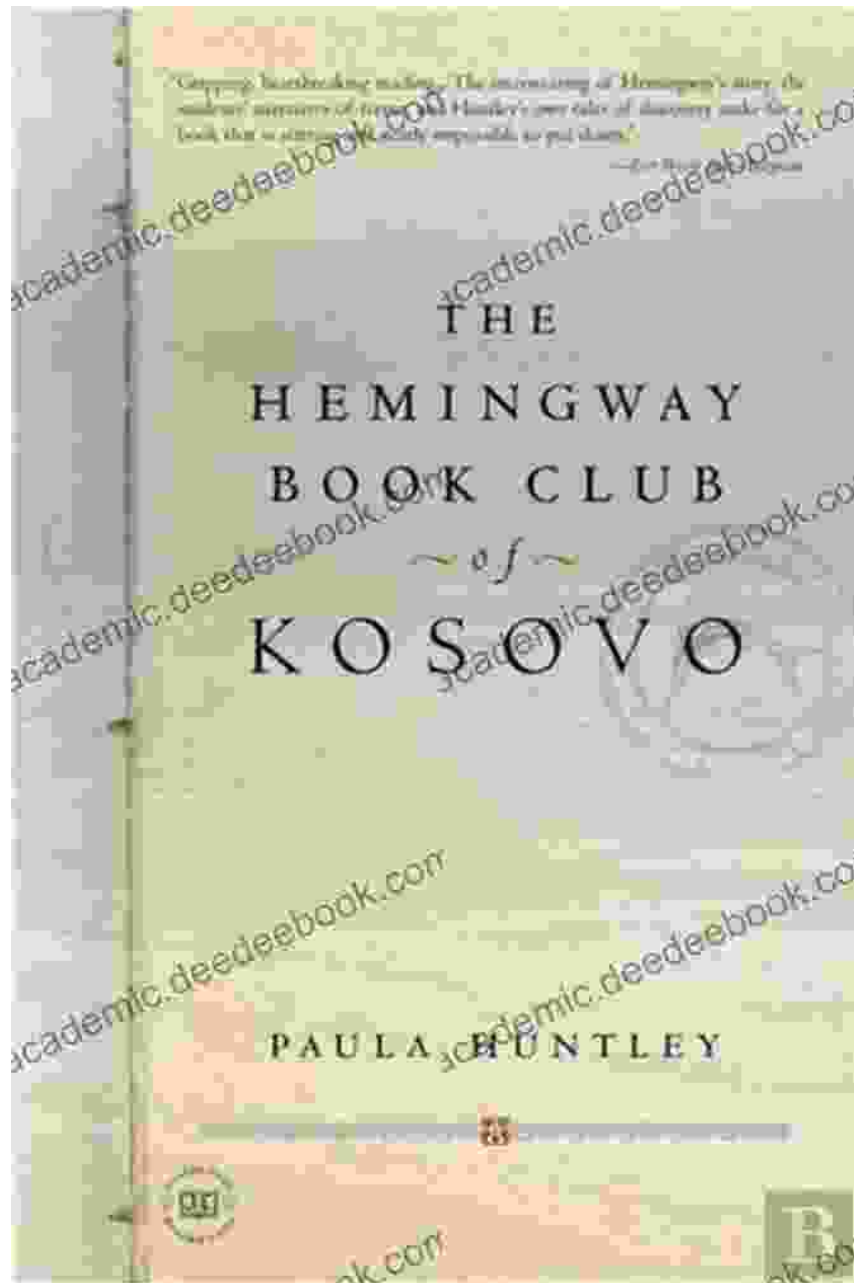




## Literary Events

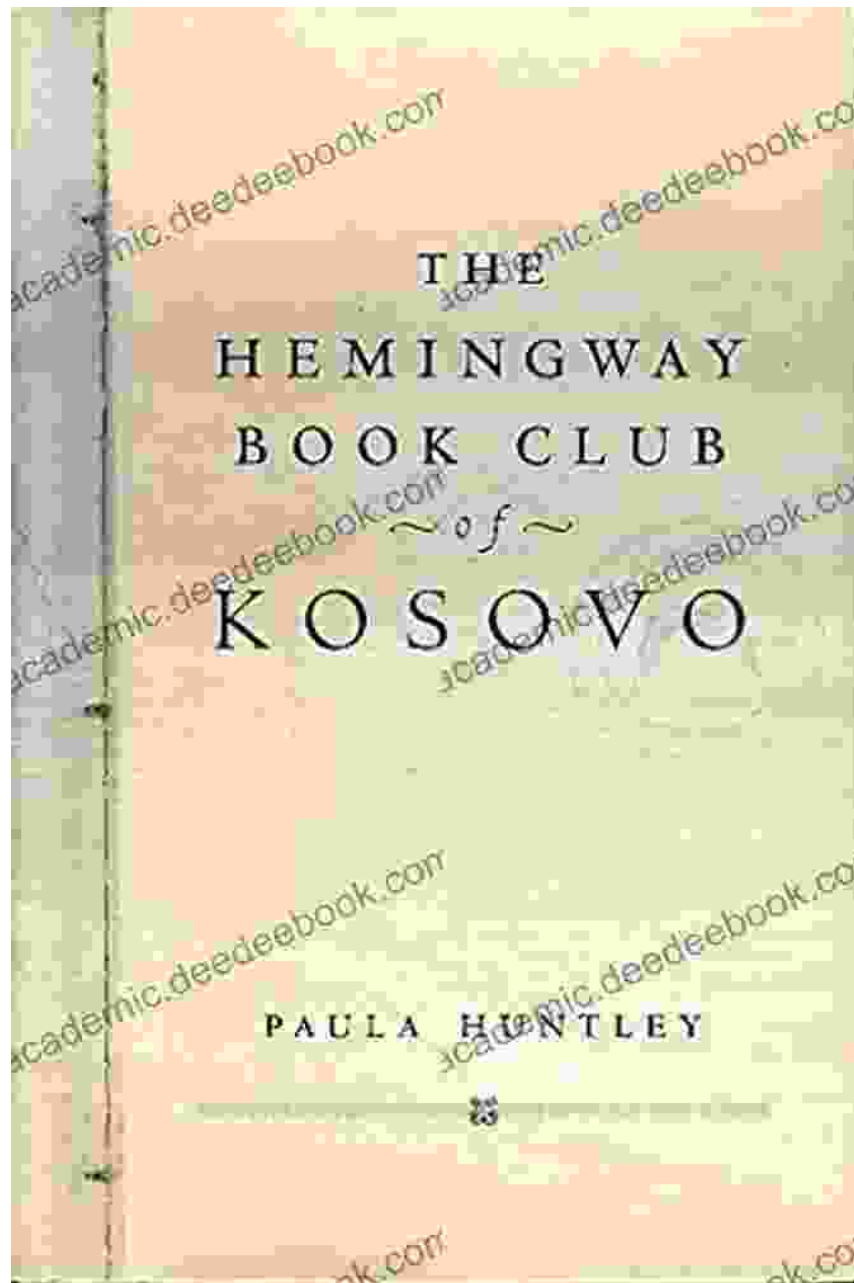


The Hemingway Salon, a monthly event where writers present their work and engage with the audience.

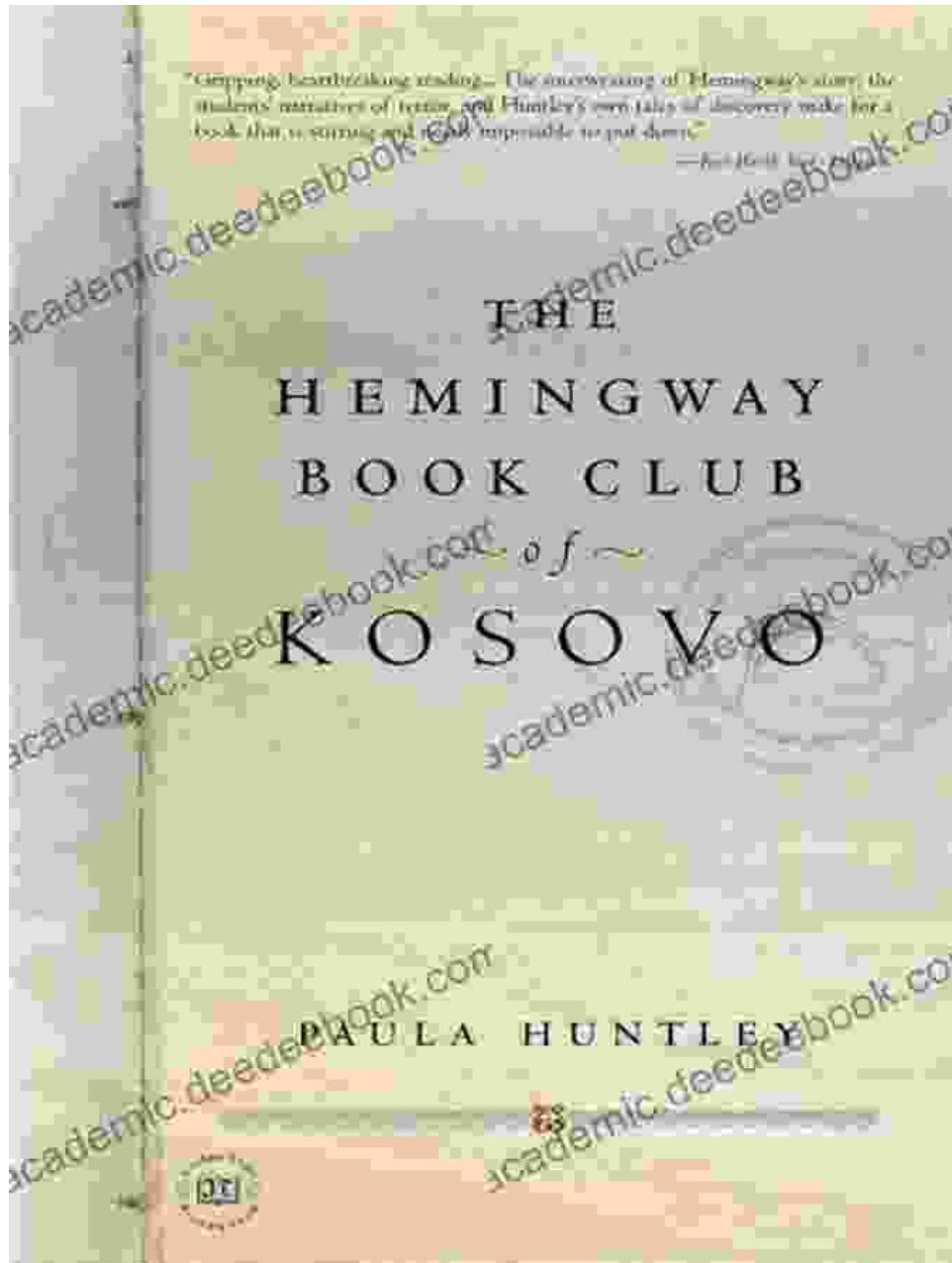

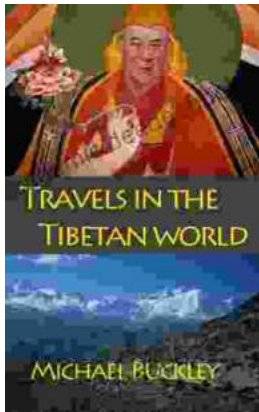

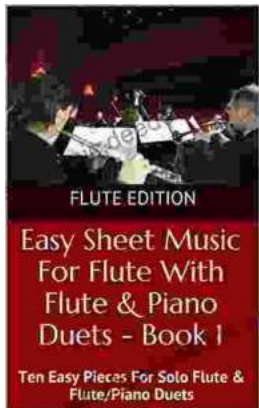
