With these fundamental stitches at our fingertips, we are now ready to embark on the creation of our lion appliqué. Let us begin with the head:

#### **Creating the Lion's Head:**

#### Round 1:

- 1. Make a magic ring.
- 2. Sc 6 into the ring. (6 sc)
- 3. Tighten the ring.

#### Round 2:

1. Sc in each stitch around. (6 sc)

#### Round 3:

1. Sc in the first stitch. Hdc in the next stitch. \*Sc in the next 2 stitches. Hdc in the next stitch.\* Repeat from \* to \* around. (12 sc, 6 hdc)

#### Round 4:

1. Sc in each stitch around. (18 sc)

#### Round 5:

1. Sc in the first stitch. Hdc in the next stitch. \*Sc in the next 3 stitches. Hdc in the next stitch.\* Repeat from \* to \* around. (24 sc, 8 hdc)

#### **Round 6:**

1. Sc in each stitch around. (30 sc)

#### Round 7:

Sc in the first 2 stitches. Hdc in the next stitch. \*Sc in the next 4
 stitches. Hdc in the next stitch.\* Repeat from \* to \* around. (36 sc, 10
 hdc)

#### Round 8:

1. Sc in each stitch around. (42 sc)

#### Round 9:

Sc in the first 3 stitches. Hdc in the next stitch. \*Sc in the next 5
 stitches. Hdc in the next stitch.\* Repeat from \* to \* around. (48 sc, 12
 hdc)

#### Round 10:

1. Sc in each stitch around. (54 sc)

#### **Round 11:**

Sc in the first 4 stitches. Hdc in the next stitch. \*Sc in the next 6
 stitches. Hdc in the next stitch.\* Repeat from \* to \* around. (60 sc, 14
 hdc)

#### **Round 12:**

1. Sc in each stitch around. (66 sc)

#### Round 13:

Sc in the first 5 stitches. Hdc in the next stitch. \*Sc in the next 7
stitches. Hdc in the next stitch.\* Repeat from \* to \* around. (72 sc, 16
hdc)

#### **Round 14-16:**

1. Sc in each stitch around.

#### **Round 17:**

Sc in the first 6 stitches. Hdc in the next stitch. \*Sc in the next 8 stitches. Hdc in the next stitch.\* Repeat from \* to \* around. (84 sc, 21 hdc)

#### Round 18-20:

1. Sc in each stitch around.

#### **Round 21:**

Sc in the first 7 stitches. Hdc in the next stitch. \*Sc in the next 9 stitches. Hdc in the next stitch.\* Repeat from \* to \* around. (96 sc, 24 hdc)

#### Round 22-24:

1. Sc in each stitch around.

#### **Finishing Off:**

- 1. Cut the yarn and pull through the last stitch to close the hole.
- 2. Weave in any loose ends.

#### **Creating the Lion's Mane:**

The mane adds a majestic touch to our lion appliqué, framing its face with a cascade of flowing fur. To



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
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
